

FISHERS FIGURE SKATING CLUB PARTICIPANT RULES AND CONDUCT POLICY

The Fishers Figure Skating Club has designed the following conduct rules for its club members to insure the safety of every skater on the ice. Deciding to skate on the Club Ice sessions requires that the skater make a commitment to skate safely and exhibit sportsmanship and politeness.

The skater whose tape is being played ALWAYS has the right of way.

The skater who is using the jump harness must always yield to other skaters.

Outburst of temper, poor sportsmanship, profanity, rudeness, kicking the ice, hitting the boards and glass, or other inappropriate behavior by skaters, parents/guardians, or coaches will not be tolerated.

Playing games, shadowing other skaters, lying or sitting on the ice is extremely dangerous and will not be tolerated.

Do not stand in groups on the ice to talk or watch other skaters. If you are not going to skate, stand by the boards or leave the ice.

If you must speak to someone in the stands, leave the ice. Please do not yell or shout into the stands or bleachers.

All skaters should follow standard freestyle procedure: jumps in the corners, spins in the center of the ice. IT IS NOT ENOUGH TO KNOW WHERE YOU ARE ON THE ICE, YOU MUST ALSO BE AWARE OF OTHER SKATERS ON THE ICE. Move to the boards to get out of the way of an oncoming skater or stand still if you are unable to get out of the way.

There is no rough-housing or horseplay allowing anywhere in the facility.

Rudeness to ANY skating professional or Forum at Fishers personnel by skaters, parents/guardians will not be tolerated. Excessive verbal abuse or harassment can result in the expulsion of the skater and/or parent from the club and/or rink.

Proper skating attire is expected to be worn by all skaters. Any items the Club views as risqué or provocative will be asked to be covered or changed.

The Fishers Figure Skating Club strives to have an atmosphere that is conducive for skaters dedicated to practicing their skills. Any Club Board Member may reprimand or take disciplinary procedures against a skater who displays inappropriate behavior. The Club reserves the right to suspend, expel, or deny participation in any of the Club activities of any individual/s whose behavior interferes, disrupts the quality of the program, and/or the enjoyment of the program by other participants. Individuals will be brought before the FFSC Board for disciplinary action.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

A skater will be warned verbally by the Board for their first incident. The time and date the rule infraction occurred will be noted by the officer, and kept on record.

The second incident shall require the presence of a parent or guardian at a meeting with the Club officers.

The third incident will result in an expulsion or suspension of the skater from the Club. There is no refund of Club dues and/or fees should the skater be suspended or expelled.
